Subject: Local author book signing and story time

Wakefield – Local author Sara Cook has written and illustrated a second children’s book which she will launch at a story telling event at the Gafney Library in Sanbornville on Friday January 12th from 10:00am to 12:00pm. The new book, “The Good He Brings About,” is about a cheerful elephant named Roland who has magical powers and is able to use his trunk to help his friends in need. The brightly colored illustrations and story line will appeal to young children who will identify with all the characters and goodness Roland is able to accomplish.

The story time will feature songs, a craft and refreshments and Sara will be available to sign purchased copies. Copies may also be purchased on Amazon, or at the Gafney during open hours. All proceeds, after cost, will go to the Gafney Youth Library.

Sara’s first book, “My Dad the Superhero” about an amputee dad, teaches children about prosthetics and sheds a positive light on physical differences. Copies of that book will be available to purchase during the book launch event.

Sara is also responsible for setting up the first “Little Free Library” in Wakefield, at the children’s park across from the Gafney. The small library on a stand within the gates of the park is available for anyone to take a book to read and even, perhaps, leave a book for the next person to enjoy.
